SIMPLE PREPOSITIONS

In addition to **a, de, con, en, por,** and **para**, the following are commonly used simple prepositions in Spanish:

ante <i>before</i>	entre <i>between, among</i>	según <i>according to</i>
bajo <i>under</i>	excepto <i>except</i>	sin <i>without</i>
contra <i>against</i>	hacia <i>toward</i>	sobre <i>on, over</i>
desde <i>from, since</i>	hasta <i>until, up to</i>	tras <i>after, behind</i>
durante <i>during</i>	salvo <i>except</i>	

COMPOUND PREPOSITIONS

a causa de <i>because of</i>	dentro de <i>in, inside of</i>
a pesar de <i>in spite of</i>	después de <i>after</i>
acerca de <i>about</i>	detrás de <i>behind</i>
además de <i>besides</i>	en vez de <i>instead of</i>
alrededor de <i>around</i>	encima de <i>on top of, on, over</i>
antes de <i>before (time, order)</i>	enfrente de <i>in front of</i>
cerca de <i>near</i>	fuera de <i>outside of</i>
debajo de <i>beneath, under</i>	junto a <i>next to</i>
delante de <i>in front of</i>	lejos de <i>far from</i>
